SAFEGUARDING REMINDERS

1. Going Home Permission

Please can we remind you that it is VERY IMPORTANT to ensure that you tell us if your child is being collected by an 'eligible person' at home time. We have a 'Going Home Book' hanging on the wall by the book bag box for you to make a note, or tell the team member on the door.
